2:00pm: Volunteers arrive and help with fields set up (mini-goals and cones), snacks and water table setup, hang corporate banners, corporate information table, etc.

3:00pm-3:30pm: Students arrive, volunteers assist in warm-ups, coaching, refereeing and supporting the students as they play, help with passing out water and snacks, taking photos and video, social media push, etc.

4:20pm: Games end, snacks and water, group photos, corporate giveaways

4:30pm: Students depart, volunteers break down fields/goals
